We invite both concrete producer and engineering laboratory employees to be Assessors. An assessor must be a CRMCA member, have experience and/or knowledge in concrete testing, and hold an ACI Field 1 Technician certification.

If you registered during the previous version of the Assessment Program, your user login and password will remain the same. If you have not been previously approved to be an assessor in this program or need updated credentials, please contact JT Mesite at jt@coloradocaa.org with the subject line "Assessor request". You must provide your name, company, First name email, and a brief summary of your experience (years testing concrete, ACI



Navigate to above the login section to download the PDF. The PDF document is a fillable form with available selections if you wish to use

it through a computer or non-mobile device while not connected to a network. The PDF can also be printed to be used when a computer or tablet is not available.

To submit the assessment, two options are available:

- a. Input the data into the website-based questionnaire or mobile app when a network is available,
 or
