

Concrete Testing Adherence Collaboration Questionnaire Guide

At CRMCA, we would like to continue to expand the Concrete Testing Adherence Collaboration (CTAC) Program. To do so, we must have excited personnel to assist us across the State of Colorado. We invite both concrete producer and engineering laboratory employees to be Observers. An observer must be a CRMCA member, have experience and/or knowledge in concrete testing, and hold an ACI Field 1 Username Technician certification.

To be an Observer for the CTAC program, please contact JT Mesite at jt@coloradocaa.org with Login the subject line "CTAC request". You must provide your name, company, email, and a brief summary of your experience (years testing concrete, ACI certification #, supervisor, etc). If

you registered during the previous version(s) of the CTAC Program, your user login and password will remain the same.

This option can be accessed by both non-mobile devices and most mobile devices.




Login using your created username and password. This is separate of your CRMCA member login.


